We have social events throughout the year to say thank you for your time. The group is of mixed age and gender and usually about ten of us meet at any one time.

The meetings happen at least 4 times a year. Sometimes the meetings are social events such as bowling and lunch. Other times we meet at Cheshire East Council offices to work together.

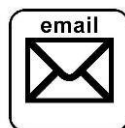
